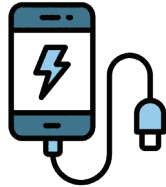




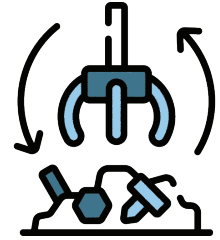
Fun Facts

20 times

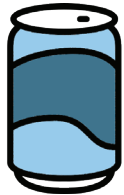


Aluminum and other metals can be **recycled infinitely** without losing any durability



Every ton of steel recycled

saves 1,400 pounds of coal
2,500 pounds of iron ore and
120 pounds of limestone



Did you know it takes **200-500 years** for a pop can to degrade in a landfill

The amount of power saved in Canada by recycling steel is the equivalent of powering



2.8 million homes

Recycled steel results in

86% reduction in air pollution and
40% reduction in water use

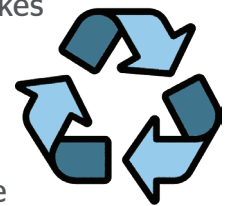


Creating aluminum from scrap uses **95% less** energy compared to the traditional way of mining for raw materials, such as bauxite

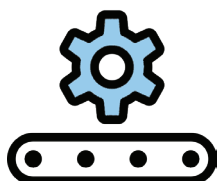
Once an aluminum can goes to a bottle depot for recycling, it takes

60 days

until it's back on the grocery store shelf for purchase



Mass production of aluminum started in 1886. Since then **over 75%** of that aluminum is still in use today



In 2019, Canada used

6.28 million tons

of recycled scrap steel for its steel mills. That's the equivalent of

How It Works



Request an account for your club from Metals4Good@secure-energy.com or by calling your nearest location. See back page for the full list. Your club must be in good standing with 4-H Alberta and we will verify before the account is created. We will require proof of identification, as per Alberta Metal Recycling Laws & Regulations. We will also verify your ID with 4-H Alberta to ensure that you are part of the club to prevent fraud.



Let your friends and family know that you are doing a scrap drive for your club. Whether you decide to drive around your community to gather scrap, or have them deliver it themselves, it's up to you!



The person dropping off scrap metal must mention what club they would like to donate the proceeds to. As per Alberta Metal Recycling Laws & Regulations, the person dropping off scrap **must be over 18**, provide government issued ID, and have a license plate. They will receive a scale ticket which lists the weights of the metals that have been dropped off. It will also show the dollar amount that will be donated to the club.



A cheque will be issued on the **20th day of the month** following when the scrap was received.



Prohibited Items

Barbed/Razor Wire, Rubber Hoses, Cement, Sealed Containers, Garbage, Tires, Page Wire, Wood, Fire Extinguishers, Brake Pots, Propane Tanks, Aerosols, Gas Cylinders, Torque Converters, Shock Absorbers/Hydraulic Jacks.

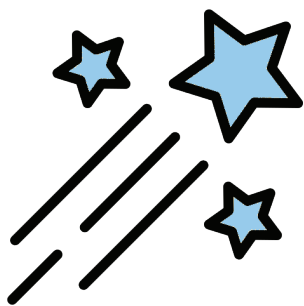

FAQs

1 What kinds of metals can be delivered to the metals recycling facility?

Non-Ferrous: Copper, Aluminum, Brass, Insulated Wire, Teck Cable, Stainless Steel, Batteries.

Ferrous: Residential Goods & Appliances, Farm Equipment, Vehicles, Industrial & Manufacturing, Cast Iron, Rail Scrap.

2 How much will the club receive for their metal?

You will receive funds based on the weight and type of metal. You will also receive a bonus from SECURE in addition to our scale price in support of 4-H Alberta.

3 Can we get paid in cash?

No, payment will be made as a cheque and will be directed to your club's mailing address that is on file with 4-H Alberta. This is to create a paper trail and to prevent any funds from being misappropriated. All cheques will contain scale ticket numbers, along with the individual dollar amounts from each person dropping off scrap.

4 Are there any special instructions for the club representative that is dropping metals?

You will need to have valid government issued ID to drop off your metal. You will drive onto the scale to get weighed, then stop at the office to advise that you are with the Metals4Good Program with 4-H Alberta. After, you will weigh your vehicle again and stop by the office to let them know what 4-H Club you are with so that funds can be directed accordingly.

5 How will my information be used?

Your information will be shared with 4-H Alberta to check that your club is in good standing and that you are authorized to receive funds on behalf of your club.
